● NEW NAVAL DOCTRINE

United States and Nato main threats to Russia, says Putin

St Petersburg, Russia, July 31

PRESIDENT VLADIMIR PUTIN on Sunday signed a new naval doctrine which cast the United States as Russia's main rival and said that Russia's global maritime ambitions for its naval strength and influence in the Black Sea.

Speaking on Russia's Navy Day, the former imperial capital of St Petersburg founded by Tsar Peter the Great, Putin praised Peter for "building Russia, a great sea power and increasing the global standing of the Russian state".

After inspecting the navy, Putin made a short speech in which he promised that what he touted as Russia's unique Zircon hypersonic cruise missiles to the Admiral Korsakov Frigate would begin within months. The location of their deployment would depend on Russian interests, he said.

Shortly before the speech, he signed a new 55-page naval doctrine, which sets out the broad strategic aims of Russia's navy, including its ambitions as a "great maritime power" which extend over the entire world.

The main threat to Russia, the doctrine says, is "the strategic policy of the USA to dominate the world's oceans" and

In Crimea, Sevastopol governor Mikhail Razvozov said Ukrainian forces struck the headquarters of Russia's Black Sea Fleet in the Russian-held port city early on Sunday, wounding five members of staff.

Lufthansa faces more turmoil as pilots back possible strikes

DEUTSCHE LUFTTHANSA AG may face further disruption after its pilots voted for strikes if they're not addressed necessary to force a wage deal, a move that could clash with another wave of cancellations unless the airline's negotiators and labor union representatives can settle their differences.

The VC pilot's union voted overwhelmingly on Sunday in favour of walkouts, meaning Lufthansa could be hit with stoppages as soon as next month. Strikes would trigger additional cancellations on top of the 7,000 flights the company has scratched this summer due to staffing shortages.

"This positive ballot does not yet necessarily lead to strike action," the union said in an emailed statement. "But it is an imminent signal to Lufthansa to take the next step of cockpit staff枕orily."

Lufthansa spokesperson said by email that the company respects the vote result and is continuing to rely on "constructive discussions" in order to resolve the conflict. Further talks with VC have been arranged, the spokesperson said, declining to specify when they will take place.

Pilot strikes at Europe's biggest airline would add to a summer of chaos across the continent, where airports and airlines have struggled to accommodate a surge in bookings compared with the pandemic-induced slowdown.

Having initially avoided walkouts that have plagued rivals like Ryanair Holdings, Lufthansa's management is facing action from its various labour unions. The carrier last week canceled around 1,000 flights at its Frankfurt and Munich hubs due to industrial action by ground staff. "We need a modern and fair, internationally competitive remuneration structure," Marcel Grooth, the VC's chief negotiator, said Sunday by email. "In the interest of our passengers, too, Lufthansa must show a serious willingness to find solutions."

For the second consecutive year, Lufthansa has faced strikes by cabin crew.
